All first place entries at the OWC Arts Festival go to District 8 competition and first place District winners go to GFWC-NC State competition. All clubwomen are eligible to compete in visual arts, crafts, photography, literature, drama, public speaking and sewing competitions as long as the individual is not considered professional. The definition of professional is “one who has specialized education, training and experience in a particular field and uses that knowledge to earn money.” Those earnings cannot exceed \$1,000 annually. There will be two categories that will only be displayed and not judged at the OWC festival. One category will be for professional clubwomen who earn over \$1,000 annually, and the other will be for non-clubwomen. There are so many talented friends and family members in our area that we thought it would be nice to show off their art work.

Attached are the summarized clubwomen directions and submission requirements for crafts visual arts, literature, drama, public speaking, sewing and photography.

We hope everyone will complete their projects and enter the festival by bringing your items to the registration on January 19<sup>th</sup>. All other items may have been completed at any time in the past and entered as long as the item was not entered in an earlier festival.
